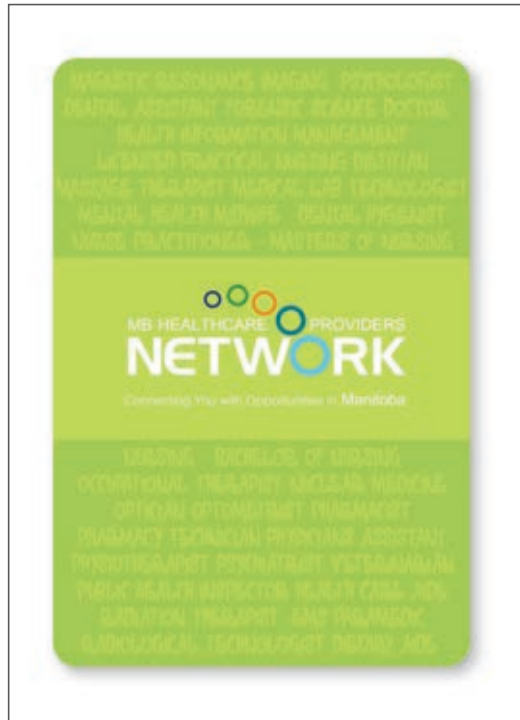


# Health Education Card Game

### Playing this Game

Each player is dealt five cards. If you are dealt a full career set (4 cards of the same career) or get a full career during game play, those cards are removed from your hand and you get a point.

Moving clockwise players take turns asking a specific player for a given career card. (example: ...do you have a Nurse career card?)

If you have that card then you give it to the player that asked, if you do not have the requested card then the person who asked must draw from the deck. This continues until all cards are matched into careers.

13 points total are available for each career card match.

Winner may be determined by the number of career cards matched or the number of points.
